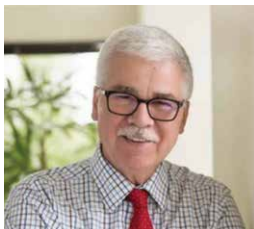

On March 4, City Light welcomed Dennis McLerran as Acting General Manager and CEO. Dennis, previously an environmental attorney at Cascadia Law Group, has represented municipal clients, ports, and utilities. With decades of experience promoting clean energy and climate action, and a background in leading complex governmental entities, Dennis will help advance the critical work of the utility. He previously served as Regional Administrator for EPA Region 10 (2010–2017) and Executive Director of the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency (1994–2010). Dennis also worked in the Seattle City Attorney's Office and led Seattle's Department of Construction and Land Use. Currently, he chairs the Leadership Council of the Puget Sound Partnership, focused on restoring Puget Sound's health. He brings extensive experience collaborating with communities, businesses, and tribes.
