Service/Program Model

The Community Connectors program is located across geographic areas in Seattle. The Community Connector engages with food bank participants to help clients navigate services that meet their needs and help enroll clients into one or more services (excluding food bank services) that promote self-sufficiency.

Participant Eligibility Requirements

All city-funded food bank clients are eligible to receive Community Connectors assistance. The Community Connector will assist food bank clients as they navigate eligibility requirements of available human services programs.
